Opening:

Julie Hundley opened the meeting and asked the Secretary to read the minutes of the last meeting and make his report.

Secretary's Report:

Lenny read the minutes from 3/19, which were accepted by the committee. He also reported posting several new forms and links. The Summer Camp link on the main page & the Events page opens a new window with links to current 2009 forms, info and a direct link to the PTC Camping page. He split up the Leaders Guide and separated out the Merit Badge section to make Guide smaller for downloading. He posted the new BSA annual health form for both adults and youth (a National Jamboree requirement) to the Forms page, along with the new editable pdf BSA Permission form. Also passed on a report from the Club regarding foodstuffs being left out in the basement, and the problems that could cause.

Outdoor Activity Coordinator's Report:

Sue reported that the Camporee was fun. She is ordering Troop T-shirts and collecting the money, if anyone wants one. Sue has the timetable for Summer Camp and reminded everyone that the early bird deadline is June 1st to get the discount. On May 31st there is a pre-camp meeting at Camp Hinds, and we will need the deposit for any of the new boys going.

Treasurer's Report:

Colleen reported an account balance of \$3700.84 and that the Internet hosting bill has been paid. She also reported that Ed had submitted a receipt for uniform expenses, which is payable from his Council account balance.

Advancement Coordinator's Report:

Tony reported that we have 23 boys showing on the roster. Charlie Dwyer and Jacob Cheney have resigned. Colleen volunteered to call the Allens to see if they are going to recharter, since we already paid the fees. New Business:

Paul Serrano will be at Summer Camp this year. Serving as Staff will be Billy working Nature, John on Kitchen staff, Stephen in Scoutcraft & Ed will be a Program Asst. Colleen announced that she is willing to help sew badges on for the boys. Merit Badge Monday is back with Art, Biking, and Music currently running. Colleen also finished the 4000ft Hiking patch and is ready to send for quote/fabrication. Lenny gave her an email for someone he knew with the equipment. Larry asked that we update the unit inventory for council, so we read off the changes while he marked up his copy.

Scoutmaster's Report:

Dave reported that the Camporee went great, though it rained at the end. He reported that the boys put together a schedule of mountain hikes for the summer, including some 4000 footers.
